Shrewsbury and Newport Canals Trust wins Restoration Award

The restoration of Bainton and Berkhamsted, a pair of Woolwich class large working narrowboats, has led to the Shrewsbury and Newport Canals Trust being announced as a winner of a Restoration Award at the National Transport Trust's (NTT) annual awards.

Bainton & Berkhamsted were built by Harland & Woolf in London in 1936 for the Grand Union Canal Carrying Company, one of 24 pairs of motor and butty. Donated to the Shrewsbury and Newport Canals Trust by their former owner Roger White, they are today the last two still together as a pair.

NTT Awards Director Paul Brook comments: The Shrewsbury and Newport Canals Trust is working hard to see the boats feature as a centrepiece at their restored basin at Wappenshall Junction, where the Newport Branch met the Shrewsbury Canal and its Trench Arm. There is a second ambitious project that is closely entwined with the restoration of the basin, where the boats will be on display for the many visitors expected. As such, the Trust is thoroughly deserving of a National Transport Trust Restoration Award."
