# **PRESS RELEASE: National Transport Trust Awards 2023**

## Nigel Bayes wins Restoration Award for his 1933 Dennis fire engine

The restoration of a 1933 30 cwt (hundredweight) fire appliance, has led to Nigel Bayes being announced as a winner of a Restoration Award at the National Transport Trust's (NTT) annual awards. The Award was presented to Nigel by the NTT's Royal Patron, Anne, HRH The Princess Royal at a ceremony held in the Railway Museum at Fawley Hill (www.fawleyhill.co.uk) on 18 September 2023.

The vehicle is the only surviving Dennis 30 cwt fire engine found thus far which carries an escape ladder (Merryweather lightweight 50<sup>°</sup>) It also has a different chassis layout to any of the few other survivors from this era and it is fitted with the rarer overhead valve engine. Nigel's aim throughout the work has been to undertake the complete restoration of NV 2881 to its former glory, that is to say to keep the appearance and equipment and overall integrity of the vehicle as near as possible to the day it left the factory.

NTT Awards Director Paul Brook comments: "The vehicle is probably unique in its configuration and represents a type of lightweight fire engine built by the famous Dennis firm of Guildford which was supplied in small numbers to local borough brigades. It is being restored to an exceptional standard and is certainly worthy of national recognition by way of a National Transport Trust Restoration Award."
