Andy Bishop wins Restoration Award for his Midland Red coach

The restoration of a 1950 Midland Red coach has led to Andy Bishop being announced as a winner of a Restoration Award at the National Transport Trust's (NTT) annual awards. The Award was presented to Andy by the NTT's Royal Patron, Anne, HRH The Princess Royal at a ceremony held in the Railway Museum at Fawley Hill (www.fawleyhill.co.uk) on 18 September 2023.

This coach, a C2/CL2 class Midland Red vehicle, has a chassis, engine and running gear built by Birmingham & Midland Motor Omnibus Company (BMMO) of Birmingham, which operated services as the Midland Red bus company. The chassis was the same as the earlier C1 coach from 1948/49. However three of the 12 C2 Coaches built were rebodied with Plaxton Embassy 1, 26-seat, 7'6" wide coach bodies. Coach number 3352 is the only example left of the C2/CL2 class Midland Red Coaches. It is a rare beast, being one of only six Midland Red designed BMMO engined coaches left in preservation.

NTT Awards Director Paul Brook comments: "Andy has been moving heaven and earth to re-instate a particularly pretty and rather unusual coach, and he is making a terrific job of it. Many would have concluded two years ago that restoration would be impossible, let alone a restoration undertaken in a pokey, leaky little space with a single three-pin plug, hemmed in between two other wrecks. Andy has done the impossible, and saved a stunning vintage vehicle. He should be very proud, and we are very proud to recognise his efforts with a National Transport Trust Restoration Award."
