Barry Ford receives Lifetime Achievement Award

Acting as the Lead Volunteer in the ongoing restoration of HMS Medusa has led to Barry Ford of Eastleigh, Hampshire receiving a Lifetime Achievement Award at the National Transport Trust's (NTT) annual awards. The Award was presented to Barry by the NTT's Royal Patron, Anne, HRH The Princess Royal at a ceremony held in the Railway Museum at Fawley Hill (www.fawleyhill.co.uk) on 18 September 2023.

HMS Medusa is a 1943 harbour defence vessel which began a five year refit funded by the Heritage Lottery following a review in 2005. Barry led the volunteer effort, stripping and rebuilding both engines to a high standard only to have his work undone when the engines were damaged by a fire at the workshop. It would have been easy to give up at that stage, but he stuck with it and motivated others to do so as well. The refit was completed in 2010 and the vessel launched and rededicated by HRH The Princess Royal.

NTT Chairman Stuart Wilkinson comments: "Now aged 87, Barry is still a very active member of Medusa's crew and is regarded by everyone as the father of the vessel; he has been with her for more than a quarter of a century. It is very appropriate that this service and dedication are recognised by this lifetime achievement award."
