Britten-Norman Aircraft Preservation Society announced as Preservationist of the Year

The restoration from derelict to Museum Exhibit condition of Charlie November, a 1967 Britten-Norman Islander, has led to Fareham, Hampshire-based Britten-Norman Aircraft Preservation Society (BNAPS) being announced as the Preservationist of the Year at the National Transport Trust's (NTT) annual awards. The Award was presented to BNAPS members Bob Wealthy, Bob Wilson, Allan Wright and Andy Clancey by the NTT's Royal Patron, Anne, HRH The Princess Royal at a ceremony held in the Railway Museum at Fawley Hill (www.fawleyhill.co.uk) on 18 September 2023.

NTT Chairman Stuart Wilkinson comments: "After a career in the Channel Islands and a subsequent move to the Caribbean, Charlie November returned to Bembridge Airfield, her place of origin, in 2000. However, conflicting priorities at the Britten-Norman company led to her being moved outside where she deteriorated considerably. At this point BNAPS stepped in and the decision was taken to restore her as a museum exhibit instead of trying to reach flying condition. This had the advantage of enabling many more of the original components to be retained and the result is an example which really is representative of the aircraft as built. The result is an excellent restoration and I wholeheartedly congratulate BNAPS as a worthy winner of our Preservationist of the Year award."
